One tool we use is routine evaluation of the data privacy policies for providers of programs our students use for digital assessment, online testing, digital curriculum resources, and digital curriculum activities. This ensures that providers are contractually and statutorily compliant with privacy standards. These measures safeguard the safety and data privacy of our students. The school district has partnered with other regional schools through the South Central Service Cooperative to utilize a software called "CatchOn Detect" that is designed to achieve data privacy compliance. "CatchOn Detect" can identify highly utilized educational technology applications and provide visibility to their privacy policies.
